Please note the following:

- **School times:**
 - Monday to Thursday: 7:15 to 2:50,
 - Friday 7: 15 to 2pm. Weekly staff meetings will be held on Fridays. Therefore, starting on Friday, September 9, 2022, and every Friday following, students will be dismissed at 2:00 pm
 - Breakfast: 7:15 to 7:45.
 - 1st period starts at 8am
- Upon entry, all cellphones and electronics must be submitted to Abu Islam in the main lobby.
- **Temperature Checks Prior to Entry:** We will still be checking students' temperatures prior to entry.
- **Dismissal:** Students will remain in their classrooms and be called via intercom to come down upon your arrival. Parents are kindly asked to remain outside during drop-off and dismissal. Guardians, parents, and drivers will be asked to show I.D.
- Our Breakfast and Lunch Program will be in effect the first day of school. Please be sure to fill out a Meal Application (1 per family).

- Please have your child in proper uniform. **Shoes are to be solid black. 2nd -8th grade girls are to wear a navy blue jilbab/abaya.**
- As per school policy, any student that is absent or sick will have to bring clearance from a doctor stating that the student is permitted to return to school.
