## EID AL-FITR



Eid al-Fitr is a major Muslim holiday that marks the end of Ramadan, the holy month of fasting, with a large prayer service in the morning, followed by meals and conversations with family and friends. The word "Eid" means "feast" or "festival". Eid al-Fitr is also known as the "Holiday of Breaking the Fast". Eid al-Fitr commemorates the success of Ramadan and the dedication to worship that took place during that month. Furthermore, the celebration of Eid-ul-Fitr is a way for Muslims to show their gratitude to Allah(SWT) for giving them the strength to fast and seek forgiveness for any sins committed during the year. It's one of two major Islamic holidays, the other being Eid al-Adha, which is also celebrated by Muslims world wide.



# **HOW TO PRAY** **SALAT EL-EID:**



**To start the prayer, an individual should say Takbirat al-ihram (“Allahu akbar” in the first rak’ah. After which, one should say six or seven more takbirs.**

**According to the hadith of ‘Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her), “The takbir of al-Fitr and al-Adha is seven takbirs in the first rak’ah and five takbirs in the second, apart from the takbir of ruku.’ ” (Narrated by Abu Dawud and classed as sahih by al-Albani in Irwa’ al-Ghalil, 639)**

**One should recite Surah Fatiha, and recite Surah Qaf in the first rak’ah. In the second rak’ah, one should say takbir as they are standing up, and once completely upright, say takbir five times, recite Surah Fatiha, and then Surah Qamar. If desired, one can recite Surah A’la in the first rak’ah and Surah Ghashiyah in the second because it was narrated that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to recite these surahs in his Eid prayer.**

**Sheikh Hicham:** I will visit friends and pray the Eid prayer in the park. I will then spend time with my family

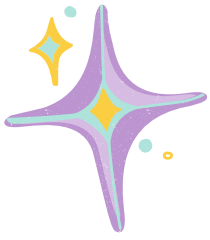
**Abu Islam:** I will pray the Eid prayer and visit family and friends

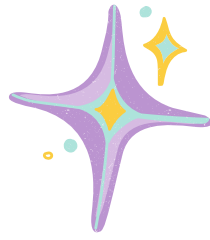
**Sr. May:** I will pray the Eid prayer and have dinner with my family and friends.

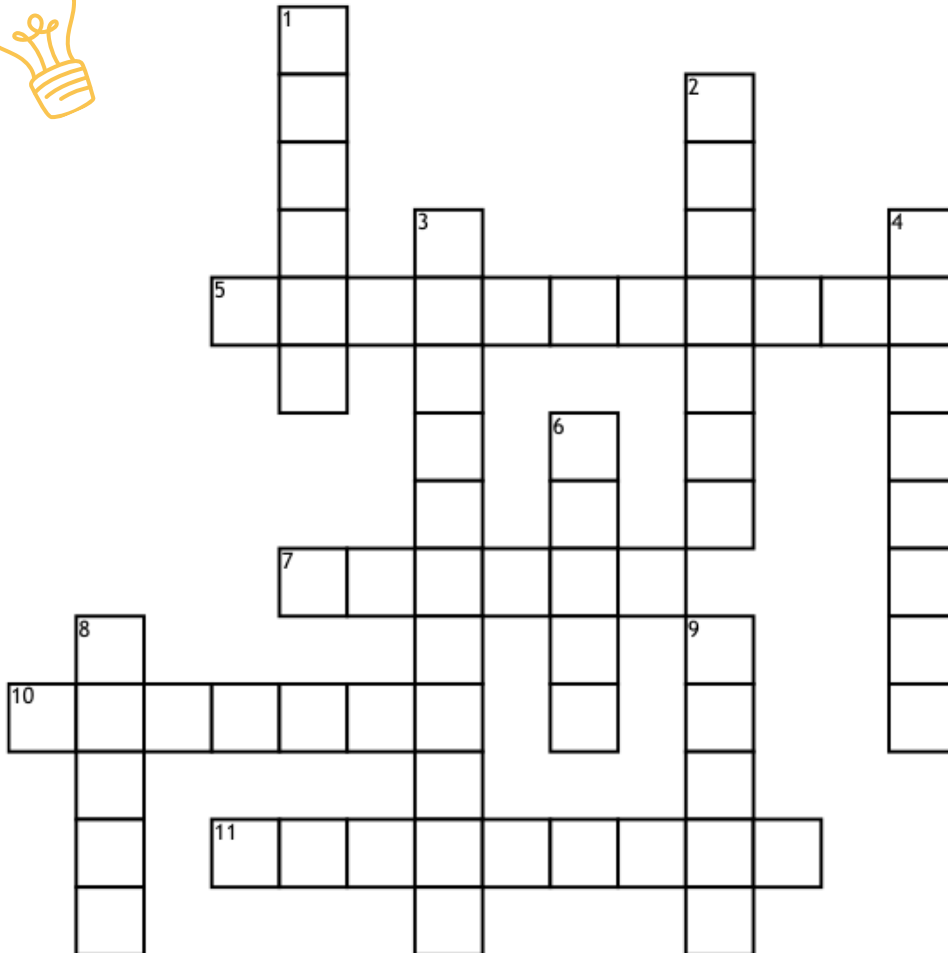

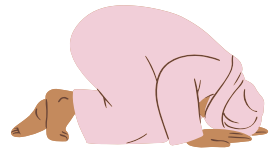

## WHAT IS THE TAKBEER FOR EID?

You should say: اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ. وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ  
Allahu akbar, Allahu akbar, laa ilaaha ill-Allah, Allahu akbar,  
Allahu akbar, wa Lillaahi'l-hamd

Translation: Allah is Most Great, Allah is Most Great, there is no god except Allah, Allah is Most Great, Allah is Most Great, and all praise be to Allah.

Allah also said to follow the sunnah of the prophet and to do as he says, so since both the prophet used to do it and Allah also told us to do the Takbeer we should say the Takbeer on Eid.

## TAKBEER AS SUNNAH

This takbeer is Sunnah according to the majority of scholars. It is Sunnah for both men and women, in the mosque, home, and marketplace.

It was narrated from Ibn 'Umar that he used to come to the prayer-place on the morning of the day of Eid al-Fitr, when the sun had risen, and he would recite takbeer until he reached the prayer-place, then he would recite takbeer in the prayer-place until the imam sat down and stopped reciting takbeer.

Al-Shaaf'ia said :

They see the new moon of Shawwaal, I like all the people to recite takbeer together and individually in the mosques, the marketplaces, the streets, the houses, travellers and non-travellers in all situations, no matter where they are. They should pronounce the takbeer openly and continue to recite it until they come to the prayer-place the next morning, and after that until the imam comes out to lead the prayer, then they should stop reciting the takbeer.





# HADITH OF THE MONTH



عَنْ أَنَسٍ، قَالَ كَانَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ  
صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ لَا يَغْدُو يَوْمَ  
الْفِطْرِ حَتَّى يَأْكُلَ تَمْرَاتٍ وَيَأْكُلَهُنَّ  
وَتَرًا.

**ALLAH'S MESSENGER (ﷺ) NEVER PROCEEDED (FOR THE PRAYER) ON THE DAY OF EID-UL-FITR UNLESS HE HAD EATEN SOME DATES. ANAS ALSO NARRATED: THE PROPHET (ﷺ) USED TO EAT ODD NUMBER OF DATES.**



## LESSONS OF THE HADITH



1. We should not proceed to the eid prayer until we have eaten some dates
2. When we eat dates before the eid prayer we should always eat an odd number of dates
